














































































My dear friends in 41 Clubs,



CRIMSON MENTURAL HYGIENE PROJECT

41er Amrendra Singh





Work on Crimson Menstrual Hygiene Project, started towards the end of 2021, during the tenure of Tangent President Jyoti Singh Deo, during her visit to New Delhi, along with 41er Vice President B K Singhdeo at The Earth Saviour Foundation. Mrs. Sudha Vohra delivered the inaugural address in the presence of Prez Jyoti. VP B K Singhdeo, Tangent members, Area Chairman 5, Samier Jain, host of 41ers and several hundred of women from neighbouring villages & volunteers of the Foundation.

Tangent India, with the support of 41 Clubs embarked on this journey and officially launched the Crimson Menstrual Hygiene Project on the 8th of March 2022 (International Women's Day).

The focus of Tangent Clubs all over India is to target slum areas, Government schools for girls, slums, orphanages and homes for women in urban and rural areas where the literacy level of women is below standard and access to hygienic practices during menstruation are minimal or nil. Each project has two parts- the first part creates awareness amongst lesser privileged girls and women and the second part is the distribution of the biodegradable sanitary napkins.

The total number of women benefitted by this project, was 9000 plus, until Sept 2023. The first phase of the project in 2023-24 reached 3000 women and girls.

The total funds spent till Sept 2023, was 17 lacs & more forthcoming in the financial year 2024- 25. The project has tied up with Aasra Shiksha Samiti, an NGO and a leading manufacturer, headed by Tangent Sudha Vohra (a member of Tangent Club 3) and her partner Rajiv Bajoria. They have put together a team and infrastructure to manufacture inexpensive, all natural BIODEGRADABLE sanitary napkins from Banana Fibre (which disintegrates very quickly, unlike plastic which takes scores of years).

The product and process are standardized and approved by Textile Committee, Govt of India. Last year about 30 Tangent Clubs participated in the Crimsons project benefitting over 9000 women and girls across India.

This year, With President Nalini Prasad at the helm, the first phase of the project has been completed with 15 clubs participating, benefitting 2250 women and girls from different parts of India, thereby impacting over 12000 women and girls already in just two year of implementation. The second phase of the projects is now running into implementation and the third phase will also be launched shortly.

This project would not have been possible without the tireless effort of 41er Amrendra Singh who continues to source funds for this project and has roped in Clearwater Analytics as a primary donor. 41er Prashant Shah also has contributed to this project in the past. We are grateful to the Round Table India Foundation that is meticulously supporting this project by routing the funds and scrutinising the details of fund utilisation.

We started our journey in the Netherlands where the 5 of us arrived on the 21st and 22nd of June. We were so graciously welcomed by Sieto and Johan of the 41 club of the Netherlands and were taken to see the city of Amsterdam. Our cultural exchange started immediately as we were offered to taste the stroopwaffel (a favorite snack of the Dutch) and herring (a specialty of the summer). The children of some 41 club members accompanied us around the city and we went on a boat ride across the canals of Amsterdam. The 5 of us from the group were also meeting each other for the first time that day so it was an amazing start to the trip!

The next two days in the Netherlands involved visits to windmills (old, new and those with historic significance), more boat rides where the boats got bigger and bigger, a swim in the lake and our first 2 barbecues of the trip! We went boating across Giethoorn (the Dutch Venice) and it was out of a dream. We got to meet many more 41 club members and also some tablers. Our second accommodation was actually a guest house which the 5 of us had all to ourselves!

We were extremely grateful for this as it allowed us to get to know each other better. We were also made to participate in a quiz about the Netherlands which truly made us realize how much we had learnt in just 3 days. We are extremely

grateful to the 41 club of Netherlands for hosting us!

We were driven to Belgium by Sieto and Johan on the 25th of June to Belgium where we first met Bobthe IRO of Belgium and a couple of other 41ers in Mechelen. We got our first taste of the Belgium beers and headed to Arlon which was only 20 kms from Luxembourg! We got to experience the French region of Belgium with a barbecue in a chateau and lots of wine with the most scenic views! We got to see Luxembourg (a bonus country for us!) and learnt about its history as well as current significance. We learnt to sing a little but our singing broke some chairs (do check out the video on Facebook) and with a heart full of smiles we headed to our next destination - Eupen which was the German speaking part of Belgium.

At Eupen we were taken to a shop which had a thousand different brands of beer! Each of us bought something we would like to try and headed to Philipps house for a scenic barbecue. We met some of our hosts and other 41 club members and tasted what is known as the best beer in Belgium! The next day we went on a cycling tour into the forests and back about 13 kms in total where the views were absolutely stunning.

We also visited the USA cemetery in honour of those who lost their lives in the Second World War. After that we went to one of the oldest churches which was also known for its Trapist beers! We tasted some of that and then headed to dinner with the 41 members where we got to say thank you and goodbye to them to head on to our next stop! We thank both towns in Belgium for having us and making us a part of their diverse culture!

We then headed to our first stop in Germany - Ludwigshafen. We were welcomed there with an extremely important hike - part of the tradition of the OT 231. We hiked up a forest and were so warmly welcomed by our host table - OT 333 and OT 231 with pins and an amazing sunset with a view of the black forest. We climbed down in the dark which was an important part of the tradition and went home. The next day we were taken to Speyer - town close by where we saw the Teknik museum and the catherdral.

We had Schnitzels for lunch which felt like a hug. We then went with the children of our hosts to Heidelberg for a night of bar hopping which was a first for us! We returned singing and dancing proving it to be a successful night! The next day we were taken for a Sunday sport - football golf. We played and relaxed and then we're hosted at Axels house for a pool party and barbecue where were given special glasses from the region! We spent the next morning in mannheim- shopping

and eating and went to the station to go to our next stop - Offenburg!

An interesting start - he surprised us by taking us to a cherry farm and then to France! (Another bonus country) we were shown how ships travel across different levels of the river and then went to a distillery factory where we even had a tasting of some gin! We went to sleep excited as the next day we were going to visit the the Europa park. And it was definitely worth all the excitement!
